This application is for any youth who plans to graduate high school in the current year. The Joe Citta, Jr. Scholarship for Outdoor Stewardship is intended for any individual interested in a degree pertaining to Outdoor Stewardship.

If you intend to apply for additional scholarships through the Nebraska 4-H Foundation, you will need to complete the 4-H Achievement Application and the Citta scholarship supplemental questions. To qualify for the Joe Citta, Jr. Scholarship for Outdoor Stewardship the individual must:

- Open to any resident of Nebraska
- Attend any 4-year post-secondary school
- Major in Environmental Education, Outdoor Stewardship, or related field

SCHOLARSHIP APPLICANTS

Youth interested in applying for the Joe Citta, Jr. Scholarship for Outdoor Stewardship and any additional 4-H Foundation Scholarships, are required to submit an application to the Nebraska 4-H Foundation. In order to be considered for the current year's award, applications must be received by January 5th. Applications need to be submitted to lshearer2@unl.edu.

*If applying for additional 4-H Foundation sponsored scholarships, please utilize the 4-H Achievement Application and the Citta supplemental questions. You must follow the appropriate steps for submitting the Achievement Application. If you are **ONLY** applying for the Joe Citta, Jr. Scholarship for Outdoor Stewardship, your application can be submitted using this form and sent directly to Lindsay Shearer (lshearer2@unl.edu) at the 4-H Foundation.

All parts of the application must be completed before application will be reviewed.

**Only the application review committee will have access to transcripts and test scores.

COMPLETING THE APPLICATION

- Applications must be completed and submitted electronically.
- Limit responses for the supplemental questions section to a maximum of five (5) pages, single-spaced, 12-point font.
- In the selection process, significant description and accomplishments in your **outdoor/environmental passions, leadership, community involvement, and career spark** will be given higher consideration than academic achievement.
- Creativity is encouraged, use bullet lists, photos, infographics, etc. to help tell your story and experiences.



A complete application includes:

1. About Me page
2. Supplemental Questions (5 pages max)
3. SCHOLARSHIP APPLICANTS ONLY: Nebraska 4-H Foundation Scholarships page
 - a. Copy of current transcripts**
 - b. ACT/SAT scores**

SUBMITTING THE APPLICATION

Please submit completed applications via email to Lindsay Shearer (lshearer2@unl.edu) if you are **ONLY** applying for the Joe Citta, Jr Scholarship for Outdoor Stewardship. If you are applying for additional scholarship sponsored through the Nebraska 4-H Foundation, you must submit your application through the Nebraska 4-H Achievement Application process.

All applications must be submitted via email to lshearer2@unl.edu by January 5. Files should be labeled with the applicants last name, first name, and Scholarship. For example: "Walker Robin-Citta"
